



Clinical Experiences: Family Practice - Overview of Year 1 – 2 Undergraduate Teaching Opportunities (Medical Students)

❖ Year 1 & Year 2 MD Students

Teaching without Patient Care – Family Practice Seminars (small group sessions)

- Session consists of 8 to 10 students discussing common family practice topics (e.g. hypertension, diabetes, vital signs, etc.)
- Detailed tutor guides are provided
- Physician commitment: As little as one seminar. Seminars run on Tuesday to Friday afternoons, 3 to 4 hours per session.
- No student assessment required.

Teaching with Patient Care - Clinic Visits

- Host a medical student in your practice for 3 or more hours per week. Students tell us that this is their favorite part of their week!
- Y1 students can take independent histories and are learning basic physical exam skills.
- Y2 students are getting ready for their Clerkship and should be able to do an independent physical and history by the end of the year.
- A brief assessment of the student may be required.
- We need preceptors for Primary Clinical Care and for Focused Family Practice (special interest in Family Practice, including sports medicine, palliative care, geriatrics, obstetrics, etc.)

❖ Preceptor Compensation

- Preceptors **must** have a Clinical Faculty Appointment to be remunerated!

If eligible (based on your payment contract):

- Year 1 & Year 2 Seminars: 3 hrs. x 1.5 units p/hr. x \$90 per unit = \$405 per session*
 - (*most seminars are 3 hours, some maybe 2.5 hours)
- Year 1 & Year 2 Clinical Visits: \$90/session for 1 student, \$110/session for 2 students
