

Documentation Checklist (2013-2014 Application Cycle)

Required supporting documents are as follows:

REGULAR DEADLINE: September 16, 2013 (12:00 noon PDT)

EARLY DEADLINE: August 15, 2013 (12:00 noon PDT)

- Transcripts** for **ALL** post-secondary institutions attended¹ (including institutions attended on exchange or as a visiting student, online courses, etc.)
 - **UBC transcripts:** please mark the appropriate box on the application if you would like us to access your UBC transcript electronically. If you do this you do not need to submit a paper UBC transcript.
 - **Re-applicants from 2012-2013:** please mark the appropriate box on the application if you would like your transcripts transferred forward and any other relevant documentation to your new file. If you have not taken any coursework since you submitted your transcript last year (August 2012) and your life circumstances have not changed you do not need to submit new transcripts or other supporting documentation.

- IB/AP transcripts** (if applicable)
 - UBC students who are claiming IB/AP credits to satisfy the prerequisites do not need to submit paper IB/AP transcripts. Students from all other institutions do.²

- Valid BC CareCard or BC Services Card** (if applicable) for proof of BC Residency

- Valid Care Card from home province** (if applicable) for Yukon, NW Territories, or Nunavut to prove BC Residency.

- Legal Name Change Documentation or Marriage Certification** (if applicable)

Due by October 1, 2013

- WES/ICES Evaluation (if applicable)
- MCAT scores must be released to UBC via the THx system

¹ An official transcript from each institution is required even if the courses/grades appear on the transcript of your home institution

² If you took the applicable courses in first or second year, or otherwise prefer to use appropriate university coursework instead of AP/IB credits to fulfill the prerequisite requirements, you do not need to submit AP/IB transcripts (do not enter your AP/IB credits on your application, either).

Note: References are not accepted until the interview stage. Do not submit any letters of reference when you apply. Similarly, proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residency is not required until the interview stage. You can check the status of your documents by logging onto the online application system.

Remember it is your responsibility to ensure all essential documents are received in the MD Admissions Office by the deadlines.
